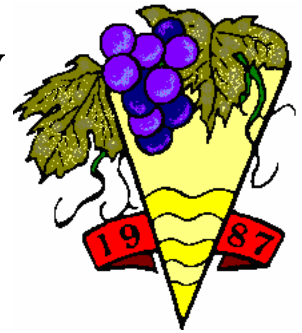

Fresh fruit summer tart, served with crème fraîche

The vegetarian option is Mediterranean vegetables with halloumi and pesto, which must be requested in advance.
